



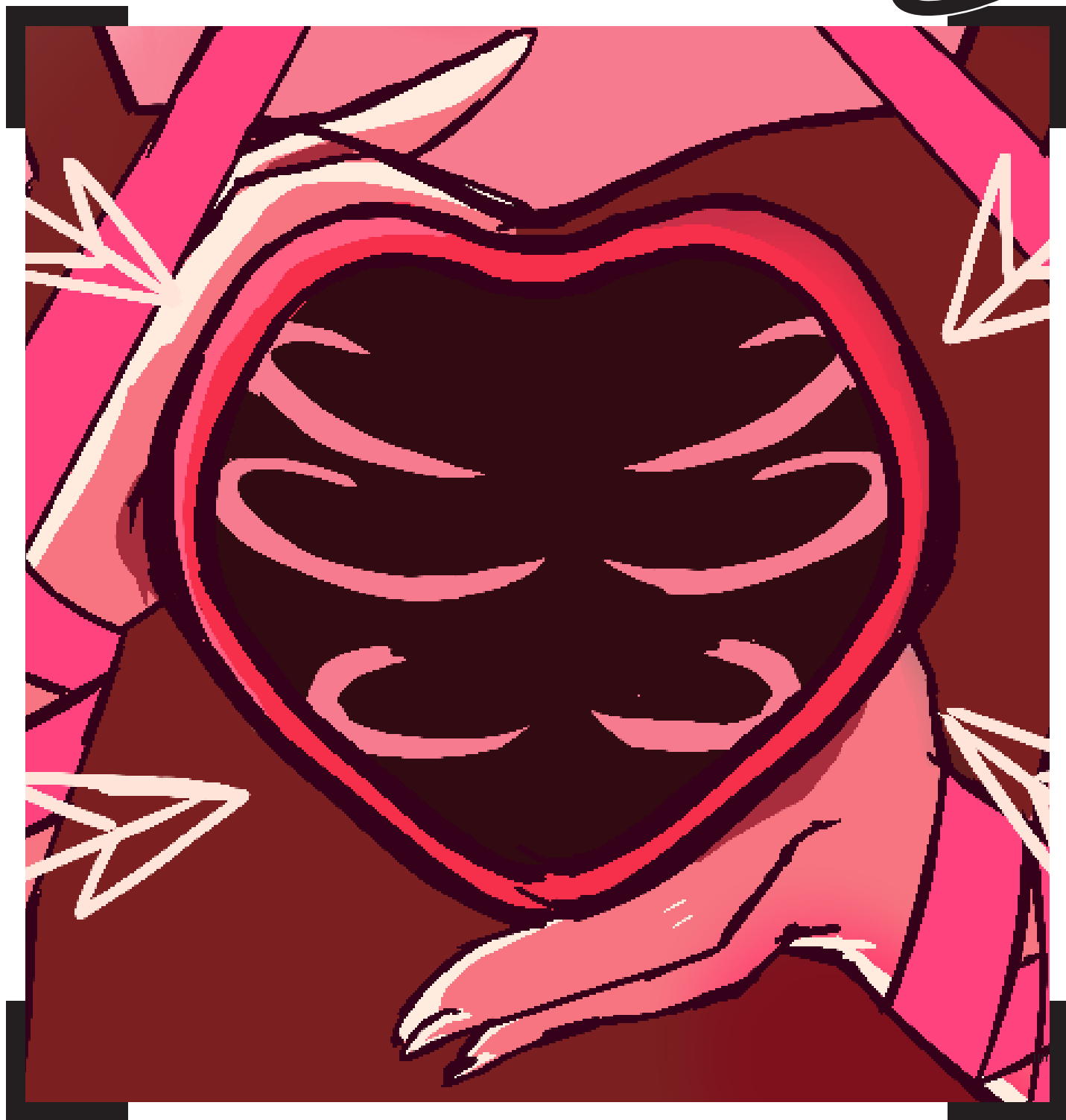

SAW: CONVINCING GORE AND PRACTICAL EFFECTS

Severed limbs. Gashed skin. Coagulated blood. Mangled faces. Believe it or not, this is a fluent language for some. Films featuring gore, otherwise known as “the splatter genre,” are a captivating approach towards immersing the audience in fear. Although many argue this genre is unsettling, many claim to enjoy a good bloodbath.

Any franchise with ten movies must be a good watch... right? Exactly. Saw is world-renowned for its gruesome and grisly kills with ten films and an eleventh in the making. Compiling a multi-million-dollar franchise in a span of 19 years, (2004-2023) feeds an audience’s constant need for malicious and intriguing stories, each unique from the others.

John Kramer, the Jigsaw killer, captures unsuspecting victims and puts them against fatal games, some of which include hacking off your own limbs. Hence his famous quote, “I want to play a game.”

This is perceived by many as a psychological trial.

The concept of fixing a troubled person’s morals and forcing them to lead their lives with a purpose is what James Wan and Leigh Whanell based the entirety of the franchise on.

These victims, usually troubled and ungrateful, have to complete the challenges in minutes which promptly adds tension. With this, the audience might feel an immense feeling of anticipation or anxiety when the victims fight for their lives.

The craftsmanship of this series isn't strictly limited to simple plot points but is filled with various practical and mechanical effects. Wan and Whanell maintained low production costs for the entire franchise, totalling 106 million USD. This includes thousands of fiberoptic needles, (Saw II) 25+ gallons of fake blood, (Saw 3D) and 73 intricate traps throughout the series. On top of that, Wan and Whanell interviewed real surgeons from the UCLA medical center, to make sure scenes were realistic and copacetic. Two thrilling traps in this franchise are; The Needle Pit (Saw II), and the Razor Box (Saw II).

The Needle Pit was a trap located on the top floor of the Nerve Gas House, the pit in the floor was filled with hundreds of thousands of used syringes. These “needles” were clipped and unable to penetrate skin. Although prosthetics and editing might make someone think otherwise.

The Razor Box, made of glass and suspended from the ceiling, is located in the Nerve Gas House with an antidote inside. Additionally, two armholes with large razors, are impossible for the victim to see. Ironically, on the other side of the box is a lock and key ready to

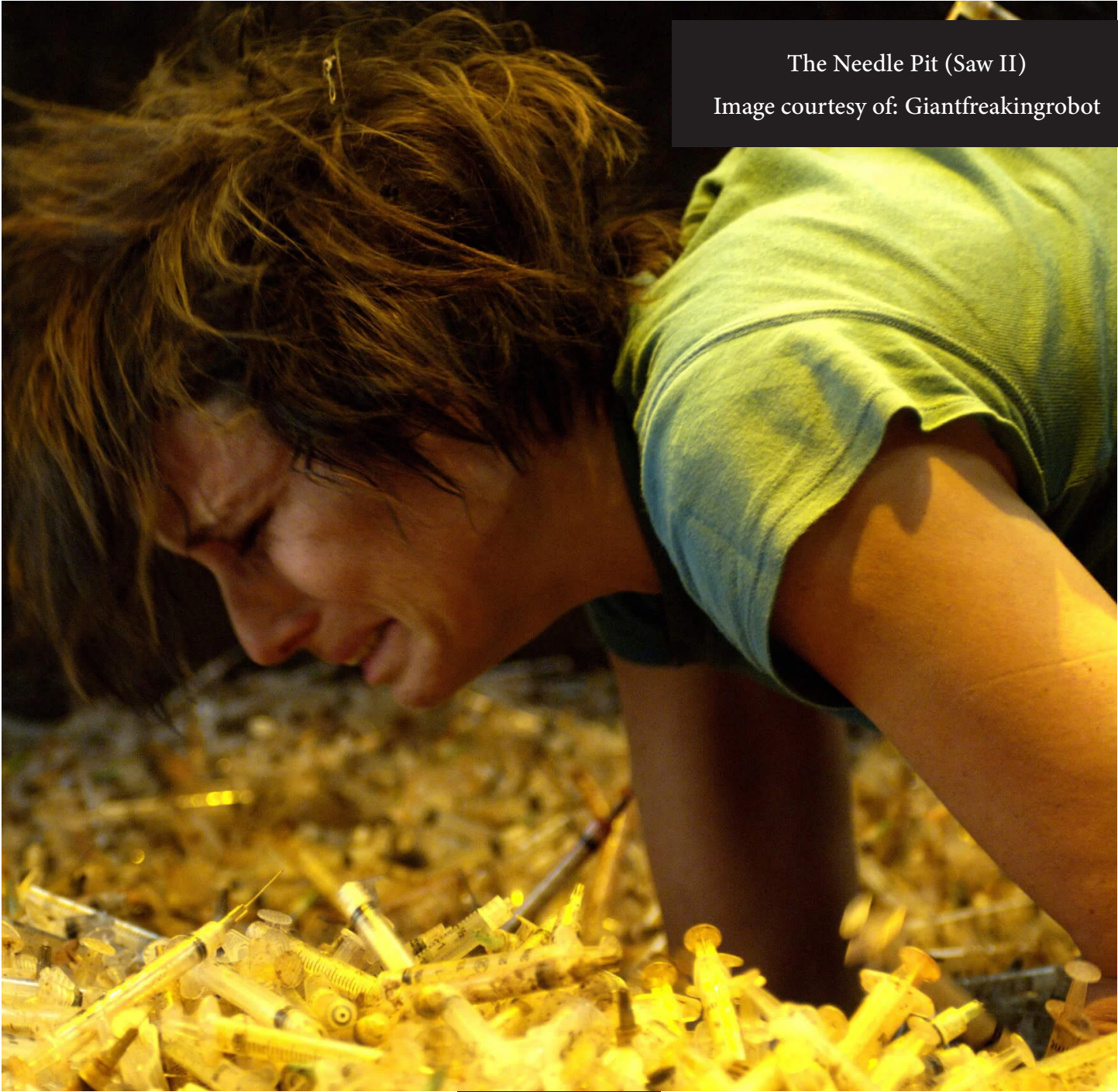
use.

Compiled with minimal CGI, and a hearty use of prosthetics, Saw is well known for its top-notch visual effects. During editing editors would grunge and grain up shots to sell the “security camera” bit. Which may double as a coverup for the low-quality filming they pulled together in 18 days. (Saw I)

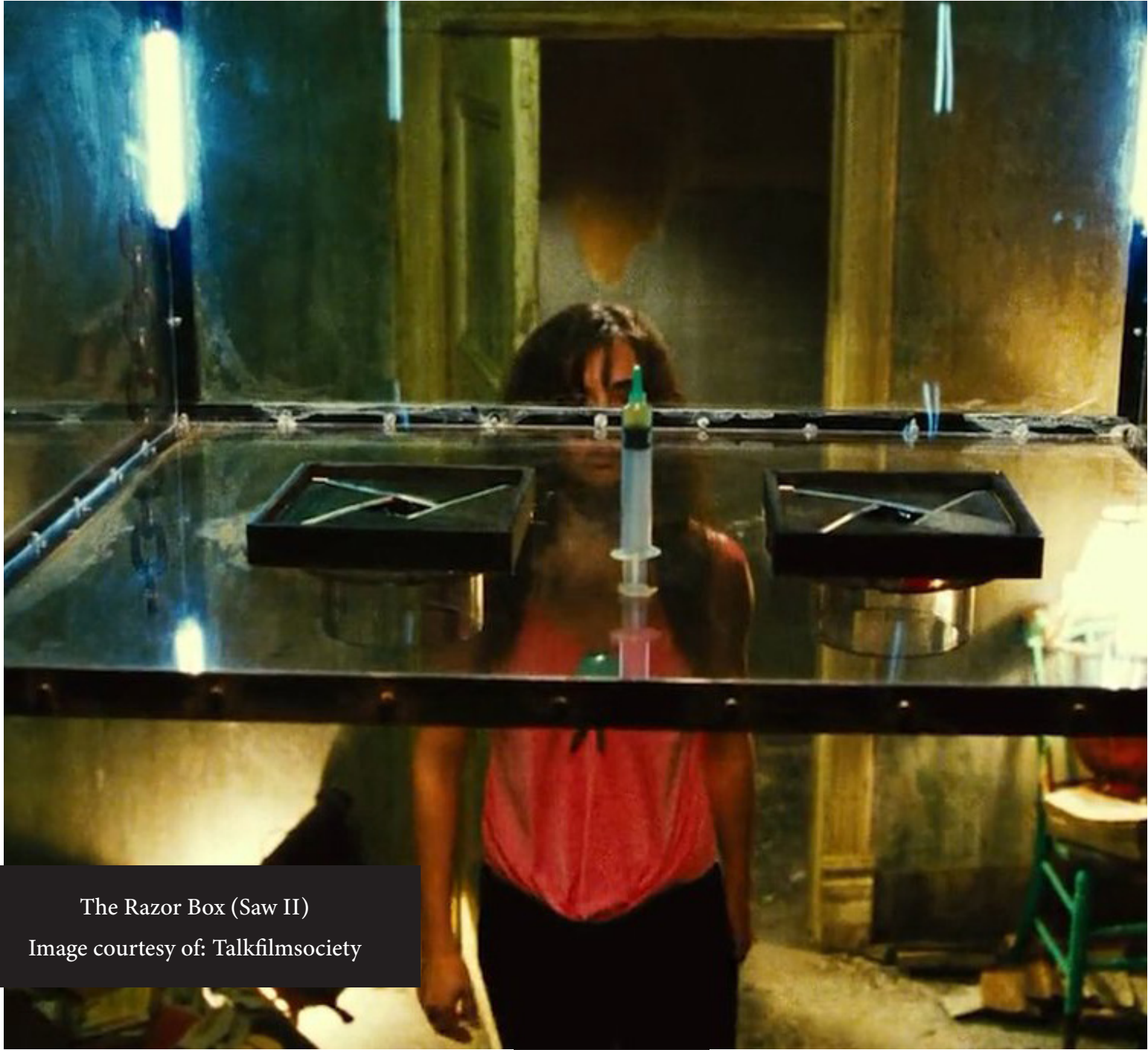
The desperation tied to life-or-death, surrounding humans is notorious for causing hasty mistakes that are normally avoidable. A person's survival instincts, although not always harmful, can cause irrational behav-

ior and adrenaline rush.

Saw is a mind-bending delve into the horror genre, and an addicting series from the start. Despite world-wide criticism, Wan and Whanell have continued to produce some of the most fine-tuned horror films of the past 20 years.

A Brief History of the Rose

"Some people are always grumbling because roses have thorns; I am thankful that thorns have roses." -Alphonse Karr

When someone thinks of a flower most will think of a tulip or lily, but everyone will think of a rose. Roses are the most popular flower worldwide

due to their ability to grow in many different types of climates. Roses have a deep history and meaning depending on the region of the world and the color of the flower.

The oldest evidence of a rose is a fossil found in Colorado. The fossil is dated to have been from 40 to 35 million years ago. Many remains of petals were found in Ancient Egypt tombs and paintings. Most famously, roses were found in the tomb of

the pharaoh who ruled Egypt during the 18th dynasty, Thutmose IV.

In Greek mythology, roses were created by Aphrodite. The flowers came from the blood of Adonis, her lover, as well as her own tears. As the goddess of love, the Greeks believe she created red roses to symbolize how love will live beyond the end of life because she created them after Adonis was killed by a wild boar.



In Rome, a festival named Rosalia is celebrated in May and June. The festival pays respect to those who have passed by leaving roses. Festivals celebrating or created by Dionysus, God of wine, featured rose garlands which the Greeks believed would prevent becoming drunk.

Roses also have deep meaning in Christianity. In Christianity a red rose is tied to Christ's blood he shed during the Crucifixion. Rosicrucian is a name with Latin roots for rose and cross. A Rosicrucian's is a cross with roses in the center and on the corners of the cross. It is a symbol often seen with the Virgin Mary and is often depicted with a Rosicrucian or surrounded by the flower.

Roses have different meanings linked to different colors. While red roses symbolize love and passion in many cultures, white roses symbolize purity and perfection. Black can symbolize death and rebirth, pink elegance or gratitude, and yellow platonic friendship. There

are many other colors of a natural rose, and each has its own meaning in literature and culture.

Shakespeare's "Romeo and Juliet," Romeo compares Juliet's beauty to a rose. The play is one of many examples of roses in literature. Grief is signified by a rose by the thorns on a rose or withering petals. A popular metaphor is a blooming rose in the presence of a new relationship. Every rose has its thorns that have been said or written in books, tv shows, and movies.

Roses have been an important part of our history and culture in ways many do not know.

The Birthstone of Each Month

January's birthstone is Garnet. Garnet can be found in all shades of red as well as orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple. The word Garnet comes from the Latin word "granatus" meaning pomegranate; the gem naturally resembles the shape and color of a pomegranate seed. Garnets represent creative light and inner healing; they symbolize trust, loyalty, and friendship. Garnets are known to bring good fortune and protect whoever wears it from negative energy.

The birthstone for February is Amethyst. Amethyst is a type of quartz and its color ranges from light to dark purple; its name (Amethyst) comes from the Greek word "nephele" meaning "sober" as it was believed to guard against intoxication in ancient Greek mythology. It is believed to provide powerful protection and help to guard against negative energy and psychic attacks. They are also known to encourage creativity, peace of mind, and intuition.

For the month of March, the modern birthstone is Aquamarine (traditionally the birthstone is Bloodstone). The name aquamarine comes from the Latin word for water, "aqua" and the Greek word for sea, "mare." The stone is thought to protect sailors and fisherman and ensure a safe voyage. It is also believed to bring good luck, peace, and prosperity.

Aquamarine has a blue-green color that tends to range from pale blue to a strong green; but they can also be found in a medium blue.

April has Diamond as its birthstone. A Diamond represents love, strength, and commitment. They can be found in clear, white, black, pink, and yellow. The word diamond originates from the Greek word "adamas" meaning invincible. Diamonds are also believed to help enhance mental clarity and focus as well as improve concentration and increase productivity.

The birthstone Emerald represents May. Emeralds are a gorgeous green. They symbolize the renewal associated with spring and they also represent truth, wisdom, intuition, foresight, loyalty, abundance, success, and love. The word emerald stems from the Greek word "smaragdus" which means green gem.

June has a Pearl for its birthstone. The meaning behind a pearl can change with its color. A white pearl often symbolizes purity and elegance, black pearls represent mystery and sophistication; pink pearls embody love and compassion, golden pearls are associated with wealth and prosperity. The word pearl comes from the French Perle, which originated from the Latin Perna 'leg', after the ham- or mutton leg-shaped bivalve.

July is represented by Ruby. Rubies are found in a variety of reds. This stone is believed to have many qualities, which include love, power, and protection. The word ruby comes from the Latin word ‘ruber’ which means red. There are also three different types of Rubies: Burmese rubies, pigeon blood rubies, and star rubies. Burmese rubies have a deep red color and are from Burma (Myanmar), they are considered the finest in the world. Pigeon blood rubies get their name from the deep red color that is said to resemble the blood of a pigeon. Star rubies often exhibit a six-pointed starlike pattern when viewed under magnification. These rubies are prized for their beauty and rarity.

August’s stone is a Peridot. These stones have a captivating green hue that ranges from a vivid lime green to a rich olive green. Peridots symbolize focus and purpose; they are said to attract good luck, instill calmness and safety, stabilize moods, reduce jealousy, and encourage a positive outlook. The word peridot comes from the Arabic word “faridat” which means gem.

September has Sapphire for a birthstone. Sapphires can be found in various shades of blue. These gemstones represent wisdom, loyalty, and nobility. The word sapphire come from the Greek word “sapheiros” and the Latin word “saphirus” which both mean blue.

The modern birthstone for October is Opal. They have a holographic color that ranges from soft white to water like blue. Opal is known for their amplitude to promote spiritual growth and emotional healing. The stone holographic nature

is said to mirror the dynamic nature of human emotions; this is thought to encourage individuals to express and embrace their feelings honestly. The word opal comes from the Latin word “opalus” which means precious jewel; and the Greek word “opallios” meaning “to see a change in color”.

November’s modern birthstones are Topaz. This stone can be found in blue, orange, pink, brown, rare varieties of red, and even colorless; most commonly though Topaz is associated with a golden yellow hue. Topaz is known to promote spiritual awareness and awakening, encourage personal growth and pursuing of a spiritual path, balance thoughts and demotions for inner healing and rejuvenation, bring one closer to the divine, and enhance psychic abilities such as clairvoyance, telepathy, and intuition. The word topaz comes from Topazios, the old Greek name for a small island in the Red Sea, which is now called Zabargad.

December has Turquoise as its birthstone. The word “turquoise” comes from the French word “turquerie” which means “Turkey”. The mineral turquoise was first mined in Turkey, where it was thought to have come from the sky. This gemstone can be found in blue or green. It is believed to provide protection from harm, boost confidence, and attract good luck. Turquoise is also said to be beneficial for the mind, body, and spirit. This gem is thought to promote positive thinking, help with anxiety and depression, and boost the immune system.

The Lovely Bones is a fascinating drama film released in 2009 by Peter Jackson written by Fran Walsh, and Philippa Boyens.

Mr. Harvey quickly flees to Norristown after proof of his crime is exposed.

Susie later finds out that Mr. Harvey is guilty of the many deaths of young women, including her best friend in heaven, Holly.

While Mr. Harvey was stalking one of his potential victims, he falls to his death down an icy slope.

The movie ends with a scene of Ruth and Ray. Ray being the guy she has always liked, and Ruth, being a girl that has always felt a deep connection with Susie. This came from the ability to sense her while she was in Heaven. Ray and Ruth grew closer as a result of Susie's death.

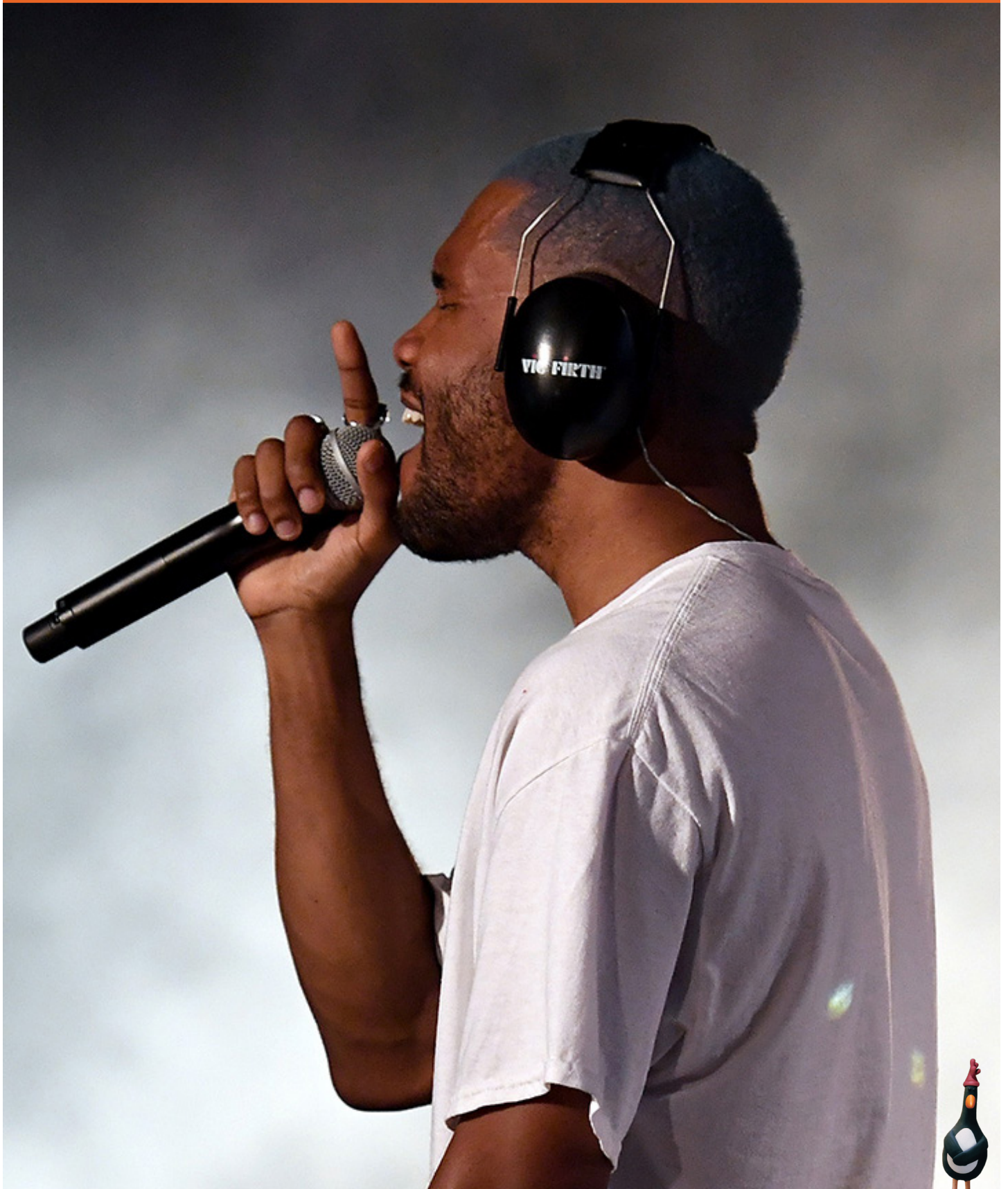
