





In Hawthorne Legacy, the sequel, each game is growing even more dangerous, and the stakes start to rise drammatically as emotional



Barnes's writing shines through clever dialogue, emotional moments, and intricate plot twists. Every chapter ends with a surprise that makes you want to read more and more of it.




This book will make you feel scared for the characters (depending on which ones you like)

War Thunder: Classifed Documents Leaked?

Just this past June a user leaked information about the AV-8B Harrier II. More specifically, the NATOPS manual for the AV-8B, and TAV-8B was leaked which is marked for Distribution Statement C, in turn means it is not approved for public access.

But what is War Thunder anyway?

War Thunder touts itself as "the most comprehensive free-to-play, cross-platform, MMO military game" available on various computer operating systems and console platforms.


That modern acronym, MMO, stands for Massively Multiplayer Online, which denotes the ability to play on a single server shared with many real players.

The game advertises the player's ability to control a wide variety of very real military platforms, ranging from aircraft to tanks, to various warships and more. And it's that ability to simulate combined-arms combat, along with its apparent dedication to realism, that has inspired a loyal fanbase since its initial beta release in 2012, later followed by a mobile version of the game released August 15th, 2023.

War Thunder's ability to pit vast numbers of real people against one another in highly realistic battles, as well as the ability to play the game for free, has cultivated a humongous player community.

According to the gaming statistics site Active-Player.io, *War Thunder* sees a jaw-dropping 60,000 & 130,000 players each day. But War Thunder's online presence extends far beyond the confines of the game itself, with countless digital communities devoted to game-related discussions found throughout the world's digital communal areas like Steam, Reddit, and, of course, the *War Thunder* forum.

It's safe to say that, while the MMO aspect of this game may scare off some other folks, *War Thunder* has a massive following that includes mili-



tary technology enthusiasts and even some who are currently serving or have served in military forces around the world. But while its realism serves as a big part of *War Thunder's* international allure, it can also become the subject of some seriously heated debates within the game's various online communities

Why do leaks keep happening in the War Thunder forums?

As far as I've been able to learn, there have been between 17 and 30 leaks of restricted documents in *War Thunder* forums so far, with the earliest dating back to July of 2021 and the most recent occurring just a couple months ago. The problem has become so prominent that the *War Thunder* wiki page has an entire section devoted to these leaks, though, to date, only 17 of the leaks I've identified are listed within it.

Of course, not all the leaks that I could confirm to date came because of digital mudslinging. Some of the leaks came from motivated players who wanted to see their favorite platforms hurried into the game. They hoped that by providing classified technical data to the programmers at Hungarian-based *Gaijin Entertainment* – the developers behind War Thunder – they could speed up getting them fielded on the virtual battlefield.

It's worth noting that *Gaijin* has its headquarters in Budapest, Hungary, and office in Cyprus, Germany, Latvia, Armenia, UAE. But originally founded in Moscow in 2002 by the twin brothers Anton and Kirill Yudintsev, and because it was founded in Russia it is very often said that Russian vehicles have an advantage even though they don't.

Gaijin was accused of providing indirect financial support to Russian-backed separatists in Eastern Ukraine in January of 2021 after logos for War Thunder and another popular Gaijin game, Crossout, were seen in a video tied to these groups. The company denied any involvement in the video in a statement released soon thereafter.

"We do not provide political support to anyone anywhere. We know nothing about politics and prefer to stay out of it. Our agency that ordered an ad in the video in question took it down when they realized they might drag us into a political discussion. We have nothing more to comment regarding this, we prefer to talk about games and games only," says the *Gaijin* statement.

So, with all that context out the window, let's run through some of the leaks to date, the systems or platforms that were compromised, and the severity of the breach in security to see if we can't assess if the War Thunder community poses a serious threat to national security or if it's just prime headline and meme-fodder in a world full of sensational takes.

As well, at the time of writing this piece, the official forum on Warthunder.com has a stated 246,000+ users, and the War Thunder subreddit has more than 330,000 and climbing. And despite writing this at on a Monday morning at 12:00 Steam not only shows more than 1,000 active discussion threads related to War Thunder, but a mind-boggling 70,000 users currently playing the game through its platform and 4,000 more in the game's group chat.

Some of the War Thunder leaks and how serious each was.

UHT-665 Eurocopter Tiger, and the date of leak was mid 2021-2022, System's Nation of Origin

France/Germany

What was leaked? According to media sources, the armor layout of the Eurocopter Tiger. This leak is particularly difficult to nail down, as the post has been cut and different media sources claim the leak occurred in July of 2021, while other sources claim it occurred in late 2022.

The severity of this leak. The rotorcraft has been in service across multiple nations over the span of two decades, it's unlikely that adversary nations do not have any reference material regarding its armor layout, but without more information regarding exactly what was leaked, assessing its strategic value is difficult.

Challenger 2 Main Battle Tank, Date of Leak was 7/17/2021, and the system's nation of origin is the U.K.

What was leaked: A player who self-identified as a Challenger 2 Tank commander in the UK military posted excerpts from the tank's AESP (Army Equipment Support Publication) to prove that the game developer didn't "model" the Challenger 2 properly in the game. AESP is, for lack of a better term, a user manual of sorts, which outlines things like maintenance and repair operations for operators.

The player claimed to be a Challenger 2 tank commander out of the Tidworth garrison in Wiltshire, which is the home of a Challenger 2 regiment. He also claimed to be a former member of the UK's Armored Trials and Development Unit

According to multiple sources, the documents had the words, "UK RESTRICTED" crossed out.

with an "unclassified" stamp over them, and did have some portions covered over.

According to a forum moderator, they received written confirmation that the images posted remained classified at the time. They posted the following response (it's the photo on this page)

The severity. While certainly restricted, the document leaked was, in effect, the Challenger 2's user manual, which is widely distributed to all Challenger 2 crewmen and maintainers both within and beyond the UK's borders. As such, it's somewhat unlikely that this leak provided adversary powers with information they were not already able to gain access to during the 27 years this tank has been in service.

DTC10-125 Armor-piercing fin-stabilized discarding sabot (APFSDS), the date of leak is 6/5/22, and the system's nation of origin is China.

What was leaked? In the first leak to emerge in the *War Thunder* forums from a non-NATO nation, a debate about the penetration capabilities of the Chinese DTC10-125 armor piercing fin stabilized discarding sabot (APFSDS), a tank-killing round leveraged by a variety of China's tanks, a user posted an image of the round sitting on top of the now declassified paper about specifications about the round.

And of course the severity. Even though it takes a bit of digging to find this image it is not classified by the Chinese government. Also, when this leak happened the image was in fact sensitive information not meant for public access


MiG-29 and Su-57, Date of the leaks goes

through 12/22 – 1/23, the systems' nation of origin is Russia.

What was leaked? In the first leak out of Russia, debate about the capability of the nation's 4th and 5th generation fighters ultimately led to the posting of two different documents.

One of these leaks highlights the Sukhoi Su-57's radar cross-section, while the other focuses on the radar system capabilities of the MiG-29.

Again, the severity. Once more, despite the restricted nature of at least one of these documents, the information contained within was hardly groundbreaking. While the thread has been taken down, the document showing the Su-57's poor stealth performance was likely the Sukhoi patent paperwork that has been making the rounds on the internet for some time. Likewise, the excerpts from the MiG-29 user manual are equally easy to come

by. In fact, the entire manual itself is available for download from multiple sources online.

So, what's the real story about the *War Thunder* leaks?

As is so often the case when stories about military technology reach the mainstream media, the real driver behind media coverage of these "leaks" isn't their technical value at all, but rather, the public's general interest in the story as a seemingly endless source of highly meme-able hot takes.

Throughout my research into these *War Thunder* leaks, I've been unable to identify anything that might provide foreign adversary nations with any truly valuable intelligence. In fact, aside from a few cases where the language barrier may have inhibited my ability to search through foreign websites, I was able to find alternate sources for these documents all over the web. Often, these alternate sources had been hosting the documents for years, and in many, the documents stayed available even after *War Thunder* moderators nuked the leaks on their forum.

Of course, that isn't to say that posting these documents in an online forum is a clever idea. It, of

course, isn't. But the truth is that national governments devote significant resources to gaining access to legitimate classified documents and designs, scour digital spaces for actionable intelligence, and go to great lengths to manipulate program insiders into revealing the latest breakthroughs in Defense technology.

For these *War Thunder* leaks to have real value to adversary nations, it would suggest that these nations have access to the *War Thunder* forums but not the rest of the internet where these documents are still available.

At the end of the day, the *War Thunder* leaks story is an exploration into how pop culture shapes media coverage with several outlets bending over backward to infer the severity of these leaks, but few make much of an effort to determine their actual severity at all. In a truthful way, a great deal of the coverage associated with these leaks could be summed up by the adage, "Never let the truth get in the way of a good story."

Of course, as Habitual Line Crosser puts it, serious or not, "the cyber training guy would be very disappointed in War Thunder players."








EXPLORING ICECREAM SHOPS IN FARGO




Natasha Preston was born on January 5th, 1988, in King's Lynn, United Kingdom. She graduated from Methwold High School and did not attend college.

Her author career started after she published her first book, *Silence*. A mystery-romance book about a girl named Oakley whose traumatic past has left her completely mute. No one including her best friend and love interest Cole knows why she stopped speaking. As the two grow closer, the truth about her past starts to resurface, forcing her to confront the secret she's been keeping for years.

This book is one of many of her romance books, with *Broken Silence* being a sequel to the first one and *Players, Bumps and Cocktail Sausages* which focuses on another character that's in the series. Plus, a short Christmas story adding on the others called *Silent Night*.

Natasha Preston never actually intended to become a writer. In a Q&A on December 3rd, 2024, she states, "I like to say I was never supposed to write. 



HORROR & HUMOR MEETS SCREAM

Scream is an American thriller franchise that includes six films. Kevin Williamson is the creator of the series, and Wes Craven is the director. The debut of the series first hit theaters in 1996 and immediately changed the public's view of scary movies.

Unlike typical horror films, Scream mixed both humor and thrill. The characters in the movie understood horror movie "rules" and talked about them, this makes the story all the more appealing for viewers.

The *Scream* movies explore different themes and make it out to be a mystery for the audience. The success of the franchise revived the genre during the 1990s, after years of predictable and repetitive horror films.

The first four films follow Sidney Prescott and her struggle against several murders disguised by what they call, Ghostface. Each movie features a new person behind the mask, who stalks and kills their victims, out of revenge and jealousy.

With the fifth movie release, they starred new cast members that are well known for their past roles, Melissa Barrera, Jenna Ortega, Mason Good-

ing, and Jasmin Savoy Brown. This brought attention to the franchise, extending its popularity even further. It was a box-office success, grossing over \$138 million.

The fifth and sixth films focus on Samantha Carpenter, her sister, Tara, and their friends. Due to the connection with the original killers, they are targeted.

Neve Campbell, Courteney Cox, David Arquette, and Roger L. Jackson were the true stars in the first five films and will return for the seventh. Cox and Jackson are the only cast members to feature in all the films.

The first film, Scream, was released on December 20, 1996. Scream 2, was released less than a year later on December 12, 1997. The third installment, Scream 3, was released on February 4, 2000, which was originally meant to be the concluding chapter of the series.

Eleven years later, the franchise was revived with a fourth movie, Scream 4, which was released on April 15, 2011. The filth film was the first in the film series to not be directed by Wes Craven, who died in 2015. Instead, Bettinelli-Olpin and Gillett directed. Scream 6 was released on March 10, 2023, developed by the same directors and screenwriters. Scream 7 is scheduled to release on February 27, 2026.

Overall, the film series has grossed over \$911 million and has been a worldwide success for the revival of slasher films.

Sheyenne High School's Student Congress team is one of the most active and accomplished forensics programs in the state of North Dakota. Meeting every school day except Wednesday in room 2304, team members spend their afternoons researching legislation, practicing speeches, and running mock chambers to prepare for tournaments. There are no requirements to join, but experience in public speaking or debate is helpful.

What makes the program stand out is the level of preparation students put in each week. Practices often include timed speech drills, rapid fire questioning, and group discussions about current events. Students work together to break down complex topics, from national security to education and healthcare policies, so everyone is ready to speak on a wide range of issues.

Returning members and students from other forensics events often take the lead during practices, guiding new competitors through formatting speeches, responding to cross examination, and explaining parliamentary rules. This helps newer students get comfortable much faster and encourages shared responsibility within the team.

Competition days are long, but students say the experience is worth it. A single tournament can include multiple sessions and hundreds of speech-



es across, giving members plenty of chances to improve. Many students are encouraged to keep personal binders or digital research folders that they update throughout the season and in the heat of chambers.

Congress is treated almost like a class of its own. The club welcomes anyone interested in politics, communication, or leadership. "Everyone starts somewhere, and there is something for everyone in forensics," said head coach Krista Hulderman.

During competition season, representatives put their preparation to the test in full day tournaments where they debate and vote on student written legislations. This season's highlight is the state tournament, held at the North Dakota Capitol in Bismarck, where Sheyenne's students debate in the same chambers used by real lawmakers in the state.

Members can also take on leadership roles, such as presiding officers who lead debate sessions or parliamentarians who record votes and manage procedures. These roles give students hands on experience in organization and parliamentary procedure.

Over the years. the team has earned multiple state titles, including State Championships in 2015, 2020, and 2021, and Runners-Up in 2023. They've also achieved several top five state finishes and district titles at the NSDA Roughrider District Tournament.

This year Sheyenne High School earned the NSDA Leading Chapter Award. Through dedication and teamwork, Sheyenne's Congress continues to set the bar for student leadership, proving that every voice can make an impact when it's heard with purpose.




Shelby Goodkin is your average Jesus loving pageant girl from the South. Her dad is a pastor and her whole family is very devoted to their faith.

Although it is hard for her at first, she becomes close with the other girls, specifically Shelby who she ends up dating towards the end of the series.


Leah, fatin, Shelby, and Toni are only four out of the eight main characters on the show. The other's are Martha, Dot, Rachel, and Nora.

There are a lot of ways that internet and



The question is, however, does social media affect students? If so, how and why does it affect them?

In a school-wide survey on how social media might affect the students at Sheyenne Highschool, data has similar trends.

Around 61% of students say that social media does not affect their learning. An estimate of 25% of students say that social media does affect their learning, and 12% say that it might affect their learning.

Most of the students who answered that social media does affect their learning explain the negative and positive effects of how social media affects their education.

A common negative effect is that social media can distract them from their learning or what's going on in the classroom.

On the other hand, some students said that social media helps them learn a lot of useful tips, including studying, or exam advice.

One student even said, "It helps me focus on what I'm doing and complete it."

According to this data, social media can be very useful for learning, but it can also distract learning.

On the other hand, does the social aspect of social media affect the students at Sheyenne High-

school?

According to our survey, around 41% of students say that social media does not affect the way they interact with others.

35.9% say that social media does affect the way they interact with others.

Lastly, around 23.1% of students say that it might affect the way they interact with others.

The students that did say that it affected the way they interact with people claim that it is mostly positive. Social media helps them connect better with other students; they may mention a meme during class or send videos to their friends to talk about the next day.

During conversations they may reference a video or photo which would bring the conversation up a level or a new topic.


Finally, we have the mental and physical effects that may occur to students when using social media. Around 48.7% of students say that it does not affect them mentally at all. Meanwhile 20.5% say it does affect them both physically and mentally.


The percentage of people who say it does affect them explain that social media can spread negativity or leave them with sleepless nights, but it can also help them interact with more people and help them get their work done.


Although social media can have negative and positive aspects, it all comes down to what you choose to do online.

Blue's Clues may have been an animated show, but to the kids it was their entire world. Steve left Blue's Clues in 2002 due to severe clinical depression.



About 90% of the counter in the front is essentially wasted space. The building had formerly been a pretty subpar salad bar of sorts.





On my second trip, to give Taste of Philly the benefit of the doubt, and to be thorough before



characters, as the wait has been so long. Filming of season 5 began in *January* of 2024 and wrapped up in *December* of 2024 after a year-long production schedule, unfortunately delayed by prior factors including both writer's and actor's strikes.

Characters

The show's main friend group consists of the core characters of *Will Byers*, *Mike Wheeler*, *Lucas Sinclair*, and *Dustin Henderson*. The group of boys love to play *Dungeons and Dragons*, in which the show bases their *upside-down* world, villains, and some events on.

Secondary characters in the show include the family members of the core group of boys including the mother and brother of *Will; Joyce Byers* and *Jonathan Byers*, the sister of *Mike; Nancy Wheeler*, as well as the boyfriend of *Nancy* at the time; *Steve Harrington*, as well as the *Chief of Police* in *Hawkins; Jim Hopper*.

The show is first brought to life when one of the core members, *Will*, goes missing. While *Joyce* frantically searches for her son, the other boys meet this girl with extraordinary powers; later named *Eleven*, from the tattoo on her wrist. They soon found out that she escaped from an institute that held little kids with superpowers captive for experimental reasons

and tested their powers for their own benefit.

Villains

The villains in the series vary from season to season, all stemming from *Dungeons and Dragons* lore. The villain in season 1 is the *Demogorgon*, season 2 brings us the *Mind Flayer* and *Demodogs*, season 3 has a return of the *Mind Flayer* and *Billy Hargrove* as the *Mind Flayer*'s host, season 4 brought us a new character of *Vecna/001/Henry Creel* as well as *Demobats*, and with season 5 trailers it seems we are getting a return of *Vecna* as he continues his mission in taking over the town of *Hawkins*.

Awards

Stranger Things has been nominated for over 300 awards over the course of its 4 released seasons. With its nominations including 57 Primetime Emmy Awards (12 wins), 18 Teen Choice Awards, 17 Kids' Choice Awards, and 16 MTV Movie & TV Awards, there's question why this show is one of Netflix's best!

The show has also received nominations such as *Saturn Awards* with 13 nominations (4 wins), 4 *Golden Globe* nominations, 2 *Producers of America nominations*, 3 *Writers Guild of America* nominations, 11 *Screen Actors Guild nominations* (1 win), as well as many others.

Viewership

There's no doubt that *Stranger Things* is popular among *Netflix* views across the *U.S*, and looking at the number, signifies the exponential growth across seasons. Season 1 averaged 14.07 million adults 18-49, within its first 35 days. It had the most-watched debut of any *Netflix* series in the year prior to its release.

Season 2 continued in the first season's path with significant growth. The first episode attracted 15.8 million viewers nationwide with the shows first three days of releasing. Additionally, every episode averaged over 4 million viewers in that first three-day window, as well as the entire season averaging 8 million viewers.

Season 3 had massive viewership growth with 64 million households watching at least part of the season within the first four weeks, and 40.7 million watching within the first four days. *Netflix* also

found that 18.2 million households finished the entire season in the first four days, as well as 26.4 million *U.S* viewers during the first four days of its *July 4th* holiday weekend release.

Finally Season 4 brought the biggest viewership yet, breaking *Netflix* records left and right. It gained over 1.4 billion hours viewed in its first 28 days of releasing, with Volume One of the season recording 286.79 million viewers. This places *Stranger Things* Season 4 in second place, slightly behind *Squid Games*.

With Seasons 1-4 grossing over 47.749 billion viewers nationwide and reaching Top 10 on *Netflix* in 91 different countries on its release week, we can only hope the release of Season 5 follows in the same steps. With the new season quickly approaching fans are eager to watch their favorite crew return to the big screen, with hopes of new record-breaking viewership, as well as possibly becoming *Netflix*'s newest number one TV show contender!

Writers/Directors

Created by brother duo, *Matt* and *Ross Duffer*, they based their unique show on a real-life situation that took place on *Long Island* in 1980. Their original plan was to film a movie with an *M. Night Shyamalan* and *Steven Spielberg* type of feel, as if they were directing a movie based off of a *Stephen King* book.

Montauk Project

The Montauk Project was a government experiment involving kidnapped kids that were later experimented on. Many subjects that were involved in the experiments recalled being part of subjects involving space, time, and other dimensions.

Other conspiracies say the *Montauk Projects* also involved experiments on mind control, sending subjects through portal into unknown spacetime, and even signs of unknown monsters.

Cast

Not only was the direction of *Stranger Things* phenomenal, but the actors' performances on screen are outstanding as well.

With many of the teen characters having their breakout roles being the show itself, they all had at least one debut appearance in a short film, TV series, or major motion film that first jump started their *Hollywood* careers!

Noah Scnapp: Schnapp, who portrays Will Byers, first started off with a voice roll as the lead character Charlie Brown, in 2015's The Peanuts Movie. That same year, he appeared in Steven Spielberg and Tom Hanks' Bridge of Spies.

Finn Wolfhard: Wolfhard, who portrays Mike



Wheeler, started off in TV shows *The 100* and *Supernatural*, as well as an independent film *Aftermath*, the Resurrection.

Millie Bobby Brown: Bobby Brown, who portrays Eleven, first debuted as Young Alice on ABC's Once Upon a Time in Wonderland. She then landed a lead role in the BBC America drama series Intruders. She also has appeared on NCIS, Modern Family, and Grey's Anatomy.

Caleb McLaughlin: McLaughlin, who portrays Lucas Sinclair, first had a recurring role on Jennifer Lopez's cop drama on NBC, Shades of Blue. He also appeared on ABC's Forever and NBC's Law & Order: SVU.

Gaten Matarazzo: Matarazzo, who portrayed Dustin Henderson, first started his career in Broadway. With that success, Matarazzo later appeared on an episode of NBC's The Blacklist.

Sadie Sink: Sink, who portrayed as Max May-field, first started her career in theater, and landed her first role as Annie, in the 2012 Broadway adaptation of the major motion movie. She soon crossed over into television in 2013 appearing on The Americans, Blue Bloods, and American Odyssey in 2015.

Natalia Dyer: Dyer, who portrayed Nancy Wheeler, debuted her first film role was in 2009's Hannah Montana: The Movie, but her first major movie role arrived with The Greening of Whitney Brown, in 2011.

Charlie Heaton: *Heaton*, who portrayed *Johnathan Byers*, started with his acting debut on the British TV crime drama *DCI Banks*, in 2015. He later went on to appear on a couple other British shows.

Joe Keery: Keery, who portrayed Steve Harrington, first appeared on USA's Sirens, Fox's Empire, and NBC's Chicago Fire. He also starred in the 2015 indie film drama Henry Gamble's Birthday Party.




